

## Terms of entry for Mobalt carpooling

### Rules for the members of a carpooling team

- I. Behaviour must be based on responsibility and solidarity with travel companions, other road users, territorial institutions, and bodies involved in the smooth operation of the Mobalt service.
- II. Subscribers will scrupulously observe the following rules:
  - a. maximum politeness in mutual relations;
  - b. respect of the appointment established at each stop;
  - c. always agree on what is allowed in the car;
  - d. have valid documents with you when crossing the State border;
  - e. care in personal and car cleaning;
  - f. avoid disagreeable attitudes, especially if they affect driving safety, such as whistles, gestures, altered and/or annoying voice tones.
- III. The members must alert the driver of the car or the Mobalt service in due time if he or she fails to comply with the agreed appointment.

### Conditions for the carpooling team's driver

- I. Ensure, as far as possible, stops at agreed meeting points and timetables. Any time or route changes are to be reported as soon as possible.
- II. In case of **serious** impediments, the team driver must warn other members of the carpooling group or the Mobalt service as soon as possible.
- III. The driver, as well as the car owner, is committed to maintaining the vehicle in good condition and always with sufficient fuel for the journey.  
The driver guarantees to drive with a blood alcohol level equal to **0**.
- IV. The driver certifies that he/she is in possession of a regular driver's license and must specifically verify that his/her RC insurance covers the insurance for all persons carried and all the possible consequences of an accident along the route.
- V. The driver agrees in advance how all team members will be sharing the costs of carpooling.
